Understanding the World	I can explore objects by linking together different approaches: shaking, hitting, looking, feeling, tasting, mouthing, pulling, turning and poking. I can remember where objects belong. I can match parts of objects that fit together, e.g. puts lid on teapot.	I en joy playing with small-world models such as a farm, a garage, or a train track. I can notice detailed features of objects in my environment.	I can comment and ask questions about aspects of my familiar world such as the place where they live or the natural world. I can look closely at similarities, differences, patterns and change.	I know about similarities and differences in relation to places, objects, materials and living things. I can make observations of animals and plants and explain why some things occur, and talk about changes.  I know that the environment and living things are influenced by human activity.
