

## Literacy

We will be immersed and taken along a journey of imagination, through some fabulous stories. There will be whole class learning followed by focus group challenges to practise the skill they are learning and independent learning opportunities for children.

### Key Skills

- I can write my name from memory.
- I can join in with repeated refrains and anticipate key events and phrases in familiar rhymes and stories. Identify the beginning and end of a story
- I can talk about the marks I have made when drawing, writing.
- I can break the flow of speech into words.
- I can label an object/picture with the initial/end sound.

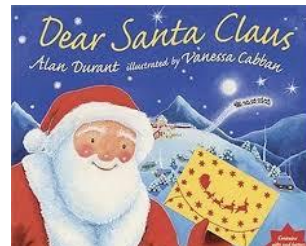
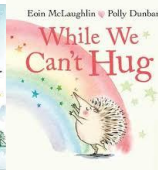
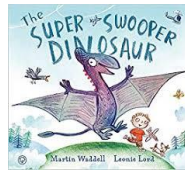
