

St Alban's Academy Sports Premium 2019 – 2020

Sports Premium Funding is money that is being provided by central government to improve the quality of Sport and PE in Primary Schools. Each year the school will receive a lump sum per pupil which is £17,550 for St Alban's Academy.

At our school the money is being used in the following ways:

- 1) To give staff an opportunity to work alongside P.E. specialists to improve quality of P.E. lessons raise fitness levels
- 2) To develop lunchtime and before and after-school physical activity clubs offered for all age groups in order to increase participations in sport
- 3) To increase participation across the school in physical learning opportunities in order to develop healthy lifestyles in our pupils.

The cost will be as follows:
